DECLUTTER

- Garage and storage areas
- Closets and cupboards
- Attic, if applicable

- Pack non-essential items in boxes
- Dispose of unwanted or broken items

STAGING

- Remove personal items
- Fresh smelling scents in home
- Press sheets and pillowcases on beds
- New towels in bathrooms
- Stage kitchen with a small lamp
- Hide cords, remotes, small electronics

CLEANING

- Dusting
- Windows outside & inside
- Clean baseboards
- Wipe counters and cabinets
- Wipe down appliances
- Wipe down mirrors and walls
- Mop and vacuum

SECURITY

- Secure all valuables
- Secure important documentation
- Lock up prescription medications
- Turn off computers
- Museum putty for items in sight
- Update access codes as needed

REPAIRS OR UPDATES

- Paint touch ups
- Replace lightbulbs if needed
- Tighten loose hardware
- Patch any holes in walls
- Tidy garage and storage areas
- Clear leaves, debris, or snow as needed
- Store hoses, bins, and tools neatly
